Many employers match charitable gifts and double what you give. Ask your HR team and we will supply the paperwork.

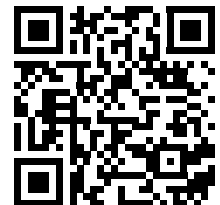
#### By check or in kind
